- Nov 5- Nor Cal Super Show @ CSU Sacramento (Sacramento, CA)
- Nov 19- WBA Championships @ Ontario, CA (overnight)

- Final show with every single band from the entire state of CA and Nevada
- Top 5 bands from each class compete in the grand championships the next day
- Discussed the send off that happens the last week of the marching season before championships, date is still being discussed

V. Budget and Fair Share

- This organization is a non-profit, the school only pays for busses for local events

- There is a great cost to running and funding all of the components of Marching band season
- The Boosters cover (by fundraising): Props, field rentals, t-shirt design/staff shirts, senior dinner/gift, trailer drivers, 9-9 dinners, bus driver hotels, equip and repairs/ emergency/misc, and guard uniforms = \$9,350.00
- Fundraising will cover: entrance fees, staff costs (music and drill), student t-shirts, food, transportation = \$35,125.00
- Students FAIR SHARE (before fundraising): \$500 per student (\$35,125/ by 67 band members)
- Championships is a separate cost: 2 night trip, Friday/Saturday come home Sunday (all by bus), planning social event possibly Medieval Times, cost is approximately \$45 per student (for Medieval Times) estimated costs: \$300-350 per student **in addition to the fair share costs (\$800-850 total per student)**
- If the championships is not financially attainable, the directors will find a substitute final show

VI. Volunteer Needs

- Volunteering hours= money off of student fair share
- Volunteer sign ups can be found on charms
 - Trailer Drivers
 - Chuckwagon coordinator & workers (they prepare, provide, and serve the meals for the different competitions) can be different groups of adults for each show, doesn't have to be the same group at each show
 - Field Crew (move equipment on and off the field for each competition)
 - Need someone to check brakes on Eagle 2
 - Donations/Items to share (if you have any connections ie food service, Frito Lay, Coca-Cola etc. that may be helpful to bringing down our costs, we really appreciate it!)
