

## **Beyer Band Boosters Parent Meeting**

I. September's minutes were approved. Motioned by Michaela R. Seconded by Melinda Haggstrom.

\*It was noted that there is approximately \$36,308 in the bank as of 10/10/23. Fair share is \$565 and about 40% of fair share has been collected.

## **Fundraising**

- Completed fundraisers
  - Panda night: earned approximately \$70
  - Play-a-thon: \$1,750 in fair share credit raised by Beyer students
- Next fundraiser
  - Ripon Pie Company (last individual fundraiser of the season) pies cost \$18 = \$6 fair share credit for each pie sold.
    - Pies must be picked up on 11/9 @ 4pm only. They are frozen and we cannot store them.
    - Pie order forms and money are due 10/30.
  - Our next group fundraiser (not for fair share, but helps the organization) Yogurt Mill 11/6 all day, any location.

## **VP of Service**

- Exchange Student Visit
  - Host families should have received an email today 10/10 with information including the schedule and agenda for each day.
  - Students in jazz band made posters for host families & student pickup on 10/13 @ 4:30pm at Beyer HS.
  - Exchange students will all receive tickets for the football game and a complimentary ticket for one host family member. Students in the band do not need football tickets.
  - Exchange students will receive a gift basket when they arrive that includes Beyer spirit wear and the football tickets for 10/13 @ Gregori HS.
  - Monday 10/16 is the host families dinner at 6:30pm. Band Council has been planning activities. We need parent help with setting up the dinner and serving. Arrive at 5:00-5:30pm to help.
  - Rally is on Tuesday 10/17 with a pizza lunch. We need parent help with picking up the pizzas if Debbie S. is unable. Pizzas are needed by the start of lunch (12:46pm) Planning on buying Costco pizza and drinks. Enough pizza for 32 exchange students + band council + host students. Parents would be reimbursed after buying pizzas and bringing them. Tuesday is the last night students are with the host families.
  - Exchange students leave on Wednesday.

- Hitch was replaced. Jack was rebuilt. Front A frame was repainted to match the Jack and Hitch. Wood & plywood floorboard replaced. Lighting was updated. Roof has lap sealant on the seams, but not all the way around the edge. Not all of the Ez track is on, but enough is.

- Been researching and trying to plan a Band, Orchestra, and Color Guard Spring Trip.
- Was originally hoping to do a Disneyland trip, but after reviewing estimates (approximately \$1,000 per student) it would be too costly and not feasible.
- Still waiting to get some estimates back & availability, but looking at two options for Six Flags Magic Mountain
  - Option 1: a one day trip until the park closes and then come home
  - Option 2: the same, but it is a two day trip
  - Hope to have more information out soon.
  - Trip would require a commitment down payment, then payment plan
- Want Parent feedback on how Parent Square is working to communicate everything Band & Marching Band.
