I. October's minutes were approved. Motioned by Alli Campbell. Seconded by Melinda Haggstrom.

II. It was noted that as of 11/14/23 the checking account balance is \$35,800. In December, this goes toward what is owed to Enochs for fall marching.

- Fair share update: 58% of fall fair share was collected. There is \$6,400 left to be collected.
- In October the taxes were filed. They were available to be looked at the meeting or upon request.

Fundraising

- Pie Fundraiser
 - Students sold 218 pies and made a profit of \$1,308 which was applied to fair share.
- Yogurt Mill
 - Yogurt mill didn't receive enough sales, for our fundraiser, for us to receive a profit.
- Chipotle
 - Our next group fundraiser is 12/11/23 from 4-8pm at the Riverbank location only.
- Senior Scholarship
 - Looking for ideas for items or treats we could sell at the concert for the senior scholarship in addition or instead of collecting donations.
 - Monday: orchestra + jazz band
 - Collect suggested donations at the door?
 - Tuesday: band concert with Ustach @ Johansen HS theater
 - Do a gift basket or sell something?
- Gift Wrapping
 - Second biggest fundraiser of the year outside of Best Buy on Sisk Rd.
 - Dec. 15,16,17 & 21-24
 - Volunteer shifts will be posted through signup genius
- Parent Volunteer Credit
 - Parents can earn \$10 fair share credit per hour of volunteer work, up to 10 hours for their student.
 - Students can earn a \$50 fair share credit for 5 hours of volunteer work if their parent's 10 volunteer hours are fulfilled.
 - Parent volunteer hours are now resetting for the upcoming winter season. Parents who worked 10 volunteer hours in the fall for fair share credit can earn credit for 10 hours in the winter.
- Cookie Dough
 - An upcoming fundraiser that will begin in January 2024.
- CVGPC hosting
 - Enochs and Beyer will be sharing co-hosting duties for two future 2024 Winter Percussion & Guard shows.
