#### 2. Budget and Fair Share

- a. Prop 28 Update- Transportation should be covered this year. This is being covered by a 1 year grant. We don't know yet what things look like for next year. Each school is getting \$30k for VAPA transportation.
  - i. Prop 28 budgets are still very tight because the district is paying stipends with prop 38 funds. Stipends eat a large amount of budget each year but we are good for this season. Prop 28 will also cover registration fees for all of our festivals, winter shows, and future registration fees

b. Fair Share Update- Fair Share should drop from \$550, once we have transportation confirmed, likely \$300-400 range, will need to be voted on by executive board. Will be voted on at next executive board meeting.

### **12. Band Director Report- Mr. Winkler**

- a. Pep Band Dates- ParentSquare notice will be sent out
  - i. 9/27 - Homecoming @ Johansen. Meet at the band room across the street from the stadium, call-time 6 PM. Choir will be singing the National Anthem. Band will play the "Fight Song" from the stands (after the National Anthem). The Homecoming parade will be before the game.
  - ii. 10/11 - **Joseph A Gregori High School**
  - iii. 10/25 - Senior Night @ Gregori HS. Ceremony before the game. Band Seniors will be recognized. Boosters to purchase boutonnieres for the our Seniors (approximately 9-10 students).
- b. Veterans Day Parade- added to Performance Calendar
  - i. 11/11 - Route starts Downtown and ends at Graceada Park. Morning parade, time TBD. All MCS band students participate in this parade.
- c. Modesto Christmas Parade (first Saturday of December)
  - i. 12/7 - Downtown evening parade. Students need lights to decorate (the more the better). Parade is judged with a chance to win a "Best Marching Band in Modesto" certificate. We won last year. Band that looks the "coolest" and most festive usually impresses the judges more.
- d. Concert Dates
  - i. Orchestra and Jazz - December 9th @ 6:30 pm

- ii. Band - December 10th @ 6:30 pm (Somerset may join us for this concert).
- e. SCMEA Honor Groups- Mr. Winkler would love a lot of Beyer student representation
  - i. Orchestra- audition music came out today. Audition date TBD.
  - ii. Band- audition music should be coming out this week. Auditions are scheduled for December 3rd @ Pittman HS.
  - iii. Concert Weekend 1/31-2/1.
    - 1. 1/31 rehearsal during school day. All day field trip to MJC, usually ends around 4 PM.
    - 2. Concert on 2/1 @ MJC.
- f. Disneyland Trip
  - i. Disney Trip (optional)- April 4-7
  - ii. All inclusive cost- 3 nights @ Embassy Suites, 2 park hopper tickets, Friday night dinner and show at Medieval Times, bus/travel expenses and a recording session at Disney Sound Studios.
  - iii. Cost is approx. \$750/student for a total of 150 Enochs and Beyer students. Students will be in charge of their cost for meals while in the park.
  - iv. Ms. Carbajal has reached out to see if cost would decrease by changing the tickets from park hopper to one park per day.
  - v. Approx. 14 chaperones needed, approx. \$500/chaperone. Chaperones will need fingerprinting and TB testing. TB tests are good for 2 years.
  - vi. Money collected within student accounts may be used towards this trip. Students must pay off their Fair Share balance before account funds may be used.

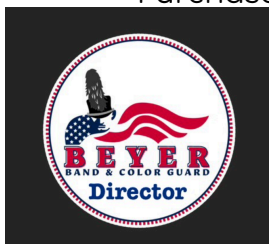
- a. Trailer- quote for tires still needed.
