#### 2. Budget and Fair Share

a. Fair Share for this season \$300 per student! Goal is 100% fundraised/donated Fair Share.

b. This covers transportation, food at shows and 9-9s, props and silks, practice field rentals, trailer driver gas reimbursement, show t-shirt, admission costs. Total budget cost is \$26,975. Number of MCMB (Modesto City Marching Brigade) members is 88.



- c. This does NOT include the price of uniforms. Uniforms were purchased separately by boosters and will be collected at the end of the season for resale/reuse.

3. Senior Dinner

- a. Need a committee to put on a senior MCMB dinner, likely at our Regional Champs show at Union City. Parents of seniors include Kathleen, Joanna, Gina, Priscilla.

4. Beyer/Enochs Disney Trip

April 4-April 7, 2025

**\$850 per student, open to all Enochs/Beyer music students**

Includes charter bus transportation, 3 nights in a hotel, 2 day park hopper pass, Disney recording session, dinner at Medieval Times. Students will be staying in a large hotel room, 6 students per room. Students' rooms will be by gender. Directors may take student suggestions for roommates, but the final decision falls with the directors. Students cannot stay in a parent/chaperone hotel room.

To keep prices as low as possible, we must take full buses. For example, if a full bus is 50 students, student #51 would be put on a wait list until enough students (from both schools) fill a second bus. The number of chaperones is limited by the travel company and is based on the number of students. Chaperones will be chosen based on the date their deposit is received. Chaperones of both genders are needed.

**Payment Plan-**

- \$200 non-refundable deposit- check/cash/charge due October 25th- Student music account money may NOT be used for the deposit. A firm commitment must be made with cash/check/charge.
- November 25th- \$250,-cash, check, charge, or student music account money
- January 25th-\$250-cash, check, charge, or student music account money
- February 25th- \$150, or balance-cash, check, charge, or student music account money

**Chaperones- limited number needed**

**\$500 per chaperone**

21 and older, Chaperones cannot have other siblings with them.

Includes charter bus transportation, 3 nights in a hotel-double occupancy, 2 day park hopper pass, dinner at Medieval Times. Chaperones do not get entrance to the Disney recording session. Chaperones cannot use their own season passes.

**Chaperone Payment Plan-**

\$200 non-refundable deposit- check/cash/charge due October 25th-

Student music account money may NOT be used for chaperones. A firm commitment must be made with cash/check/charge.

November 25th- \$100- cash, check, charge

January 25th-\$100- cash, check, charge

February 25th- \$100 or balance- cash, check, charge

    1. 2 students received Angel funding. That account now has \$75.76
